



Our Future Plans

Building on the successes and lessons of the 2024 season, UBC ThunderBikes is preparing to compete at AHRMA Formula Lightning Race 2025 in Hastings, Nebraska. Our latest creation, 'SM25,' marks our third-generation electric racing motorcycle. Building on the legacy of its predecessors, it incorporates significant advancements, reflecting our commitment to excellence and continuous improvement

- Redesigned batteries to optimize fit within the GSX frame, lowering and centralizing the center of gravity.
- Upgraded motor and motor controller for improved performance.
- Engineered a new sub-frame to securely house batteries and provide optimal mounting points for the updated system.
- Enhanced cooling systems for all electrical components.
- Designed and manufactured PCB circuitry for relay and pump systems.
- Developed and evaluated two display designs, selecting and producing a sleek, effective unit.
- Fabricated tail fairing, gas tank cover, battery covers, and side fairings using wet lay-up techniques.


Ways to Support Us







